This interactive workshop helps adults gain an understanding of the relationship between healthy sexuality and child sexual abuse prevention. Participants will learn to identify normal sexual behaviors of young children, respond to young children's sexual interactions, respond to young children's questions about sexuality, respond appropriately to children's disclosures of sexual abuse and identify and report suspected child sexual abuse.
