Get Me Off This Roller Coaster: Coping Skills for Emotional Intensity Issues

Emotional intensity disorders, particularly Borderline Personality Disorder (BPD), are unique both in their diagnosis as well as in the manifestations of behaviors that accompany them. Also unique is Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), which is an evidence-based therapy for Borderline Personality Disorder. This course will provide participants with an overview of DBT skills, strategies for mindfulness as well as ways to validate others. Emotion regulation skills and interpersonal effectiveness skills will be taught as well.
